Year 6 Plant Out Excursion – Giving Back to the Bush and Growing Together

On Tuesday, 17 June 2025, Year 6 students from Boddington District High School stepped out of the classroom and into nature for the annual Plant Out excursion — a meaningful, hands-on experience focused on environmental stewardship and community connection.

Supported by a dedicated group of volunteers from Newmont, South32, Friends of the Reserve, PHCC, the Lions Club, and the P&C, students worked in teams to plant over 2,000 native seedlings along the creek bed near Blue Gum Park. As they got their hands dirty, students learned practical skills like plant spacing and placement, while also discovering the vital role native revegetation plays in restoring biodiversity, improving soil health, and supporting local wildlife.

The day was filled with laughter, collaboration, and curiosity — including one unforgettable bug encounter! Beyond the fun, students gained a deeper appreciation for the local environment and the shared responsibility we all have in protecting it.

This excursion reflects a whole-community approach to education, where students, families, local organisations, and volunteers come together to foster learning that goes beyond textbooks. It's an experience that not only benefits the students but also contributes to the health and future of the entire community.

After a morning of hard work and learning in the field, students enjoyed a well-earned sausage sizzle and juice box, generously provided by the Lions Club and P&C, followed by a friendly game of silent ball before returning to school.

Applications for 2026 Kindergarten enrolments are now open for children born between 1 July 2021 and 30 June 2022. Applications can be picked up from the administration office or downloaded from the website.

Please bring to the administration office:

- · Your child's original birth certificate
- Immunisation records (downloaded from the My Gov website)
- Proof of Address (Recent utility bill, rental agreement or purchase agreement)
- Court orders (If applicable)
- Documentation of any medical condition or disability

If your child is not a permanent resident of Australia, please bring your child's Passport and Visa documentation.
